As with the previous titles all these: **Getting Dressed, Favourite Food, New Shoes, (set E)** and **Going to School, The Building Site, Post Office, Vehicles, (set F)** with the exception of **Holidays, (set E)** have an urban setting; and each has the characteristics of the other books in the series: good, clear colour photos and easy-to-read text of one or two sentences per page. The repetition of sentence patterns makes the books suitable for children learning English as a second language as well as for the beginning readers for whom they were designed. Because of their cultural diversity however, these books are recommended for all primary classrooms.
