How many children learning to count (and presumably the purpose of these books is to help them) will see the relation between the photograph on the right-hand page and the pattern of hexagons on the left to which a reduced version of the right-hand picture is added? The whole thing strikes me as thoroughly confusing - the object being added to make up the number shown and illustrated on the left is shown on the right-hand side so, for example, the page with 2 comes *before* the photo of the object which is being added to make up that number. Lovely colour photographs and nice big, bold print, but if you want counting books don't buy these.
