I enjoyed getting to know Mollie and warmed to the relationship between her and her father. There are plenty of interesting sub-plots to keep the reader's attention and a colourful collection of characters offering a good deal a variety in tone. This will sit well on library shelves and would be likely to interest Year 7/8 girls.
