Inside the tunnel and Browne's illustrations is a world drawn from her imagination and the fairy tale, a world which has to be explored. How much of this world the reader discovers will depend upon powers of observation and his or her own imagination and knowledge of fairy tales. This is Browne at his most haunting.
